



OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE ANNUAL VFL DUCK RACE

Presented by Volunteers for Literacy of Habersham County, Inc. (VFL) (the “Presenter”), to benefit community literacy projects and programs in Habersham County, Georgia.

- 1.** When you purchase your numbered duck race ticket, your ticket number will be paired with a toy duck bearing the same number. The individuals’ names written on tickets with numbers corresponding to the winning ducks will be awarded prizes. A list of prize winners will be posted on the Volunteers for Literacy website (www.vflhabersham.com) and its Facebook page within one week following the event.
- 2.** By state statute (Georgia code § 16-12-22.1), all winners must be at least eighteen (18) years of age unless accompanied by an adult.
- 3.** The combined value of all prizes will be \$1,750.
- 4.** The entry portion of each race ticket must contain the purchaser’s name and phone number and/or email address and delivered to the Presenter, or an authorized representative of the Presenter, and actually received by the Presenter prior to the race for a ticket to be eligible to win any prize. No other tickets are eligible to win any prize. Entrants assume the risk of non-delivery of any entries to Presenter or an authorized representative of Presenter.
- 5.** The three toy ducks to first cross the finish line in succession (first, second, and third) will be declared winners. Winning ducks (and their corresponding purchasers) will be announced at the conclusion of the duck race, and they will also be announced on the Presenter’s website and Facebook page. Winners shall be determined by the Presenter in its sole and final judgement.
- 6.** Each winner has sole responsibility for paying any and all taxes and similar fees on any prize(s) won and must authorize the deduction of such taxes, if any, from the prize(s) to the extent required by law.
- 7.** By entering, entrants release the Presenter and its members, directors, agents, employees, and other related entities from any and all liability with respect to prizes.
- 8.** By entering, winners consent to promotional use of their names and likeness without additional compensation.
- 9.** Chances of winning depend on the total number of tickets sold.
- 10.** Members of the Volunteers for Literacy Board of Directors and their immediate families are ineligible to receive prizes.
- 11.** This event is subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited by law.
- 12.** The conduct of the race and the determination of race winners will occur at the annual Clarkesville Mountain Laurel Festival. Should the festival be cancelled or postponed, the Presenter may, at its discretion, hold a drawing to determine winners. All decisions and interpretations of rules and regulations will be made by the Presenter and its judgment is final.
- 13.** The VFL Duck Race, its logo, and the logo of Volunteers for Literacy of Habersham County, Inc. are the property of the Presenter and no other person or entity is authorized to copy or otherwise use them without the Presenter’s express written consent.

- 15.** If the Presenter determines, in its sole discretion, that the event cannot occur at the scheduled time for any reason, then the Presenter can postpone the event to another date and time by public announcement thereof.
